ELECTORAL ROLL - ANNUAL AMENDMENTS

This year's review of the 2019 Roll is due to be completed in time for the APCM. Any amendments and new application forms must be submitted by Friday 27 March. Forms can be downloaded from the website (under the 'About' tab), are available in Church, or from the Church Office.

New Parishioners need to note that if you wish to be formally recognised as a member of the St Margaret's Church and to be entitled to vote at the APCM, your name should appear on the new electoral roll. The principal qualifications for enrolment are that the applicant must be baptised; aged 16 or over, and be a member of the Church of England.

After revision, a copy of the amended roll will be exhibited at the Church entrance from 5 - 19 Chris Harris, Electoral Roll Officer April.
