

Saturday 21st

Women Together are having Breakfast today. Ask the Lord that this will be a time to make lasting and meaningful friendships and that everyone will cement their relationship with Jesus in a new way.

Sunday 22nd

Thank God for **the members of our welcoming team**. It makes such a difference to everyone when they walk through the doors and receive a smile and a handshake.

Today is **World Water Day**. We may grumble about our water services but there are still billions of people without access to safe drinking water. Offer the Lord a prayer of thanks for what we have and remember those whose lives are blighted because they don't have water.

Monday 23rd

Launched in 2007 with 20 participants, **the Sussex Gospel Partnership** has grown to include more than 70 churches and individual ministers. Pray for Spencer Shaw (Director), Wendy Jourdain (PA) and Jon Hobbs (Trainer) as well as the nine members of the steering group, that they will hear God's voice. Pray also that they will not become over-stretched as they juggle other demands on their lives.

The **PCC** meets tonight. Pray that they can see clear direction in their deliberations.

Tuesday 24th

Ask for the Lord's protection over all our activities in church and that he will give our **safeguarding team** vigilance and wisdom. Pray that every volunteer will remain alert as they create a safe environment for all who come.

Wednesday 25th

The tots and their parents or carers meet for **Easter CAMEO** today. Pray that they will all get a sense of the wonder of Easter and what Jesus did for all of us.

Is there more to life than this? Pray that people wondering about that will come to the **Alpha Taster Session** this evening. May they feel comfortable enough to ask their searching and awkward questions and pray that the Holy Spirit will speak into their hearts.

Thursday 26th

Isn't it a blessing when a passage of scripture you may have read a hundred times, suddenly comes to life! Ask the Lord that as the **Daytime Fellowship** meets together that their scripture will truly bless their socks off!

Also: bring the ongoing work of **MAF** to the Lord today, especially the need for new pilots and engineers.

Friday 27th

Pray for the mental, emotional, and physical well-being of **our children and young people**, especially those navigating pressures at school, friendships, or home life. Also bring to the Lord those of us who are **long term carers** or facing serious illness and ask that they never lose sight of Him.

Saturday 28th

Pray for our **Easter services**, that they would deepen friendships and encourage people in their walk with God. Pray that the Holy Spirit would be at work in the hearts of our young people, helping them grow in their understanding of God's love and His Word, and in particular that they would feel comfortable and confident enough to ask questions and explore the meaning of faith.

Sunday 29th

Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Matt.

20v. 9 We celebrate **Palm Sunday with an All Age Family Service**. Ask God to bring his word to life this morning, and the people to New Life in him.

Yes – today there's another **Sunday Roast!**

Because the Easter celebrations fall at the beginning of April, SR has been moved to today. Pray that the real meaning of the cross will come home to all those who share this special meal.

Monday 30th

Our teams are stretched in the **5pm services**. Ask the Lord of the harvest to call more workers into the field. May He raise up new volunteers. Ask yourself, 'Can I answer that call?'

Tuesday 31st

Thinking of the many thousands of people who now live in **Angmering**, ask God to help us to find new ways of reaching them for Christ. A move to a new area is always full of promise. Lord, we ask that that they will not simply step into a new house but into a Faith which will last for all eternity.

Our Mission this Month – Sussex Gospel Partnership: a partnership of Bible-centres churches in Sussex working together to train leaders, strengthen and plant churches, and advance the gospel.

Sunday 1st

It takes a lot of dedication and hard work to produce **Sunday Roast** which follows 11.30 **Morning Prayer**. Ask for



God's blessing for the cooks, waiters, those laying the tables and washing up, as well as those who collect the guests. Jesus said, 'whatever you did for one of these... you did for me.' *Matthew 25v. 40*

During term times, **Rooted** meets in the church hall with a meal and games together before they look at Biblical topics. At the same time a homegroup called **Sunday Girls** meets. Pray that strong bonds will be formed and that all will come to faith.

Monday 2nd

Father, thank you for everyone whose work is dedicated to **caring for people**: please encourage doctors, nurses, those in the emergency services, police and the armed forces. We pray for them, that their mental health will be healthy and that none shall harm them as they serve the people of this country.

Tuesday 3rd

Bring **Helen Sheridan**, who is currently on sabbatical, before the Lord today. Ask our Father that she will enjoy some good family times and that she feels completely released from her church duties. Also thank God for and remember Calvary Church while she is away.

Wednesday 4th

Meet and Mingle come together today. It's an opportunity for a cuppa, conversation and company, but ask the Lord that it may also be a means of meeting with Him.

Ask our heavenly Father that the church **Prayer Meeting** will be a time when we as believers seek a deep intimacy and quiet communion with God as we make our requests. Pray that we have unity with our fellow believers, that we share one another's burdens and that we really hear from God.



Thursday 5th

St Margaret's **Music and Memory Café** meets again today. Ask the Lord that people will enjoy the relaxed and friendly atmosphere and that they are comfortable with the gentle activities. Pray that perhaps it may rekindle long forgotten memories of times when they used to spend time with Jesus.

Friday 6th

Today let's offer up prayers for our local schools, especially **St. Margaret's primary School**. Ask God's blessing on the teachers and support staff. Also pray for senior schools and colleges and for Christian students seeking to be a positive witness. Pray that Christian CU or assemblies would be fruitful and encouraging.

There is a **World Day of Prayer Service** in church today. Organised by the Christians in Nigeria and with the theme, 'I will give you rest,' pray for the persecuted in that nation and for an end to the violence and murder.

Saturday 7th

As we ask the Lord's blessing on the **Saturday Morning Mission Prayers**, please pray for the 270,000+ refugees from South Sudan, who are now in settlements in Uganda. Especially bring the children to the Lord. Many have fled from violence, having lost their parents or whole families. Ask God for healing, comfort and peace in their new community and pray for wisdom and blessing for **Tearfund's** local partner, who works in the settlement.

Sunday 8th

Lord, I'm all too willing to come to you as a beggar believing myself poverty stricken and empty handed when the fact is, I am a child of the King – heir to all your riches including every insight and revelation I need for each prayer request. Lord, help me to reset my thinking and be confident that you hear and answer every prayer. I ask that you will make the services on this Sunday special to each one of us.

Monday 9th


Becky and Dave Waterman have still not finalised the purchase of their house which can be frustrating. Also pray for Dave's work at **MAF**, for wisdom in researching new technologies and in knowing which projects to pursue. He may travel abroad, so ask for God's help in the planning and prioritising of trips. **The Marriage Course** has its final session tonight. Pray that the marriage of each couple will be revitalised and Christ centred.

Tuesday 10th

Slicks Sports bar in Worthing is where a **Men's Snooker / Pool evening** is happening. Ask the Lord for good relationships to be formed and that the ground work will be laid for sharing the Good News. **Tearfund's** mission partner Stephen is in Ethiopia helping to ensure that the Church Community programmes are working well. Ask the Lord for safe travel and rich interactions which will lead to God-focussed ministries.

Wednesday 11th

The Bible Overview Course continues today. As participants explore the sweeping story of God's plan from Genesis to Revelation, and see how beautifully everything fits together, pray that folks will get a better understanding of scripture and grow in their faith and confidence.



Thursday 12th

As the **Bereavement Group** meet today, ask God that each person will find the support and companionship they need. Pray that the pain of loss will not overwhelm them and that they find comfort in knowing Jesus

Friday 13th

Thank God for the **children and youth** who attend our groups each week, and for the joy, energy, and openness they bring. Ask the Lord to bless our committed volunteer leaders and helpers who so faithfully serve with love and patience. Ask God that they may have a joy of leading young people to Jesus.

Saturday 14th

Ask for God's blessing on the small group of people who are coming together today to make posies for **Mothering Sunday**. May the Lord bless the work of their hands and fill them with His joy!

Sunday 15th

Traditionally **Mothering Sunday** is a joyful time when we give thanks to God for mothers but it can also be a difficult day for some. Ask the Lord for a special blessing on those women who long to be mothers but for some reason are unable to have a family and for those who struggle with a tarnished memory of their mother.

Monday 16th

There's a training session for **the leaders of the under 18's** today. The team has been using resources from the Growing Young Disciples website but they also crave clarity and unity as they seek God's direction for the future.

Tuesday 17th

He took bread, gave thanks and broke it and gave it to them saying, 'This is my body given for you...' (*Luke 22v.19*) Ask for God's blessing on those who will be sharing **Holy Communion** today. As school years 5-8 meet in **Adventurers**, pray that the games, challenges and Biblical input can help build relationships and prepare younger ones for secondary school. Pray that the children will surrender their lives to Christ.



Wednesday 18th

Thirty pupils from St Margaret's primary school will be singing at **Evergreen** today. Ask for God's blessing on the folks who listen and the children themselves.

Bible Overview Course meets for the final session today. Ask the Lord to help everyone fully grasp that all they've learned points to Jesus and that from now on, their private meetings with God will be filled with joy.

Thursday 19th

Pray for the people who spend their Sundays on the sound desk and the screens. It's a sad fact that we probably only think of them when something goes wrong. Thank God for them and ask him to bless them in ways we can't. Why not ask God to remind you to say thank you to them in person on Sunday.

Friday 20th

Today, thank the Lord for lifting up **FEBA partners** in Cambodia, Central Asia, Pakistan and India. And pray that their broadcasts and audio ministries will accomplish God's plans and purposes.
