Thursday 1st

Sunday 11th

Today is the **Annual Parochial Church Meeting** after the morning service. As we digest the reports about various ministries and church finances, please pray for the year to come that His will be done on earth as it is in heaven. As the youth lead the **5pm service**, pray they will be aware of His presence. **Monday 12th**

Please pray for all our **parents**, **grandparents**, **godparents and carers** at St. Margaret's that they will be equipped and sustained to help the children in their care to know Jesus. Pray that as a church we may support them in this vital role as they seek to grow young disciples.

Tuesday 13th

Monday 19th

During Lent we were all encouraged to pray for **two people for two minutes** a day. It's easy to start with enthusiasm but then 'life' gets in the way! Remember the two you promised to pray for before the Lord today. Maybe put their names in between the verses of Ephesians 1v. 17- 18(a).
