At **the services today**, ask the Lord that each person will meet with Jesus. Pray for transformed lives.

Monday 22nd

The members of our **PCC** have an enormous responsibility. They always act in the best interests of the church, making balanced and informed decisions, and thinking about the long term as well as the short term. As they meet today, ask the Lord to give them wisdom and insight so that they will make good choices.

Mission prayers meet this morning. Sunday 7th

Sunday Roast is back! Ask the Lord's blessing on those who prepare and host it and that those who come will renew friendships and fellowship but most of all that they will come to know Jesus.


